Summary of Washington County's Policy on Rocking Roads

1. The County Engineer will determine the appropriate granular surfacing materials to be placed on the road.
2. The County Engineer will determine if the County will haul the granular material or if the applicant will contract the hauling to an experienced private party.
3. Contract haulers must come from a list of haulers approved by the County Engineer. Contract haulers must be insured and assume all liability.
4. If the material is contracted out, hauling will need to be coordinated with the Engineer to ensure a motorgrader is available to assist in spreading the material on the road.
5. All material and hauling costs are to be paid by applicant. If the County chooses to haul, the hauling charge will be \$3/ton. Terms of Washington County billing are net 30 days.
6. No sections of road with dust control will be rocked over without approval from the County Engineer.
