ROAD GRINDING TO BEGIN ON THE KEOKUK WASHINGTON ROAD AND G26

On May 14, 2020 a roadway patching and grinding project will begin on the Keokuk Washington Road (V15) and 190th St. (G26). This work will take place from highway 92 north to the intersection of 190th St and east to the intersection of Gingko Ave. The contractor awarded the work for this project is Diamond Surface, Inc., of Rogers, Minnesota.

On Thursday, May 14, 2020, Diamond Surface, Inc. will set up flaggers and start patching various locations within the project limits. If weather permits, they will continue with grinding on Monday, June 1, 2020. The contractor expects the project to last approximately 6 weeks.

While the road is under construction, it will remain open to thru traffic with the use of flaggers and pilot cars to assist in directing traffic through the work zone. Drivers are urged to slow down, use caution and follow the direction of the flaggers as they travel thru the work zone. They should also be prepared for delays when traveling. The work for this project involves concrete patching and grinding of the road surface, all being done to increase the longevity of the pavement and improve the ride.
