ROADWAY PATCHING TO BEGIN ON COUNTY ROADS

Road closures can be expected on paved County roadways as a contractor works to patch deteriorated pavement according to the Washington County Engineer's Office. Cedar Falls Construction Co. of Cedar Falls, IA will begin work the morning of Wednesday, October 20, 2021.

The roads to be worked on include Ginkgo Ave (W-38) and 190th Street (G-26). The work will reduce traffic to one lane in work areas for periods of time. The work is expected to take 2-3 weeks, weather permitting. Drivers are encouraged to use caution in construction zones and pay attention to roadway signage.
