

DON PFEIFFER SHOOTING & ARCHERY RANGE

THE RANGE IS OPEN FROM SUNRISE TO SUNSET OR BY WRITTEN PERMISSION AND CONSENT OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARD. THE RANGE IS OPEN TO USE BY CERTIFIED PEACE OFFICERS, APPROVED GROUPS, AND PERSONS CERTIFIED BY THE WASHINGTON COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARD.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded, at all times.
2. All firearms shall be checked for obstruction before firing.
3. All firearms shall be kept under control and pointed in a safe direction, at all times.
4. No firearm which is malfunctioning or in need of repair shall be permitted on the range.
5. No person shall go in front of the firing line until firing has ceased, weapons have been made safe, or at any time while a firearm is being handled by another.
6. All ammunition shall be checked for proper size and caliber for the firearm being used.
7. All persons using the range shall "Carry in, Carry out". **All items that a person brings to the range shall leave the range with that person. All litter, including all shells, live or spent, shall be picked up and removed when they have completed firing.**
8. The use of eye and ear protection is strongly recommended for persons using or observing the use of the range.
9. Spectators of the shooting ranges shall stay a safe distance behind the firing line.
10. Use of the shooting range shall not be permitted when any surface water is present on the shooting lanes.
11. Range certification is only possible upon the completion of the range certification course, arranged by the Washington County Conservation Board. *Certified persons 21 years of age or older are allowed to bring a maximum of two non-certified guests to the range.*
12. Only paper or cardboard targets are permitted on the range. Targets shall only be placed on the designated backstop. No steel, hard surfaced, tannerite, explosives, or any product alike will be permitted on the range. Persons using the range shall not shoot anything except their designated target. **VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE and PERMANENT REVOCATION OF RANGE PRIVILEGES.**
13. Only firearms and ammunition that are legal to possess in the state of Iowa will be permitted on the shooting range.
14. No person shall possess or consume alcohol while at the shooting range. No person who is under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or any intoxicating substance(s) will be permitted on the shooting range.
15. No person shall injure or kill any wildlife while at the shooting range.
16. No person shall cause unnecessary damage to any property of the shooting range.


CLAY TARGET SHOOTING AREA

1. Shooters shall not possess shells with a shot size larger than six (6).
2. Only Clay Targets are permitted and must be thrown from the designated platform.
3. No more than 3 persons (2 shooters and 1 thrower) shall be on the firing line at the same time. All other persons and spectators must stay a safe distance behind the firing line.
4. Shooters shall not fire shot outside the left (west) and right (east) boundaries of the clay target area.
5. No person shall go in front of the firing line until firing has ceased and firearms have been made safe.

ARCHERY RANGE RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Target arrows ONLY may be used on this range. No firearms are permitted.
2. All shooting is to be from a single designated shooting line with arrows aimed and released at targets ONLY.
3. No person shall knock an arrow or shoot at any time when anyone is in front of the designated shooting line (such as when they are setting targets or retrieving arrows). Persons going forward shall notify all other shooters.
4. No usage is permitted on the Archery Tower unless given special written permission from the Washington Archery Club.
5. Persons over 21 are allowed to bring a maximum of 2 non-certified guests but are responsible for their actions.

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF THE VIOLATOR(S) SHOOTING RANGE PRIVILEGES, FOR A LENGTH OF TIME THAT WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE WASHINGTON COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARD AND OR ITS DESIGNEE(S). IN ADDITON, CRIMINAL CHARGES MAY ALSO BE FILED.
