ROADWAY PATCHING TO BEGIN IN SOUTHEAST WASHINGTON COUNTY

Pavement patching is scheduled to begin on Spruce Avenue and 305th Street in southeast Washington County and may slow travel through the area.

Beginning on Monday September 8th, weather permitting, Midwest Contractors, Inc. of Cedar Falls, IA will need to close some lanes on Spruce Ave and 305th St so work can take place safely as they patch the road. Drivers will be directed through the work zone with the use of flaggers and a pilot car. This work is expected to take 1-2 weeks.

The Washington County Engineers Office encourages drivers to slow down and use caution in work zones and to pay attention to roadway signage. Drivers are also reminded that traffic fines for moving violations are double in work zones.
