**VARIOUS CANADIAN PACIFIC KANSAS CITY SOUTHERN RAILWAY (CPKC) ROAD CROSSINGS
TO BE REPAIRED, BEGINNING THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 4TH**

Beginning on Monday, September 8th, subject to weather conditions, the Canadian Pacific Kansas City Southern Railway (CPKC) will begin working on replacing various timber crossings on Washington County Roadways and will result in the closure of various road crossings to make the repairs. Specifically, CPKC personnel will be working on the Cedar Avenue, Ivy Avenue, 260th Street and Kiwi Avenue road crossings. The exact schedule and order of work will be determined by CPKC Railway and is dependent on weather and other railroad work. The work is expected to take 1- 2 weeks to complete.

It is anticipated each closure and crossing repair will take approximately 10 – 12 hours, depending on train traffic. During these closures, the public is urged to use alternate routes and to exercise caution if traveling the area of the work. Questions about the project can be directed to the CPKC Railway.

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
