**MID-AMERICA PIPELINE, LLC TO REPAIR PIPELINE ON 220TH (G36), BEGINNING MONDAY,
SEPTEMBER 15TH**

Beginning on Monday, September 15th, subject to weather conditions, Mid-America Pipeline, LLC will have a contractor begin work repairing their pipeline crossing 220th Street (G36) between Spruce Avenue & Redwood Avenue. This repair work will be on the north side of 220th Street and requires the contractor to excavate the pipeline near the travel way of 220th Street. As a result, the westbound lane will be closed in order to protect the work area and the traveling public while the repairs are being made. Traffic moving through the work zone will be controlled with temporary traffic signals. This lane closure is scheduled to be set up at 9:00 am on Monday September 15th.

It is anticipated that the lane closure and repair will take up to 1 week to complete. During the closure, to avoid delays, the public is encouraged to use alternate paved routes around the area. If you must use 220th Street, motorists are urged to exercise caution while traveling through the work zone and be prepared for delays to their travel.
